Since the Card-O product was originally designed to be a playing card game (like War), all print runs were set up to produce some multiple, or subset of 54 cards (52 cards plus 2 Jokers), thus subsequent non-game Series are all thought to consist of 27 subjects – printed in sheets of 108 cards.

It is believed that the 5 "Miscellaneous Navy" cards from the Mixed Series were printed at the same time as Series 'A', to make a total of 27 different cards.
